Significant financial accounting and financial management experience required. Certified Public Accountant (CPA) preferred. Extensive experience and understanding of financial statements. Ability to assess and evaluate complex data and use it to determine potential credit risks. Exceptional leadership, management and facilitation skills. Demonstrated ability to skillfully counsel, collaborate and negotiate; inspire and build confidence in others; create alliances; obtain support and respect from diverse groups and foster an understanding and commitment to the ministry. Ability to adapt style and approach to match the needs of varying teams, individuals and situations. Extensive knowledge and experience leading and managing complex organizational change and performance improvement. Analytical ability to conceptualize well in unstructured, fast-paced, dynamic and multi-functional environments requiring creativity, innovation, foresight and mature professional judgment. Must be able to draw upon already established relationships with large national foundations to partner in community investment and grant making. Exceptional interpersonal and relationship management skills to develop effective, collaborative and productive working relationships and partnerships with all levels of management and staff in the organization. Ability to influence results and tactfully manage complex relationships and influences within and across the organization and to effectively represent the system to varied and diverse internal and external groups. Demonstrated ability to represent Trinity Health to external stakeholders with the necessary level of respect, confidence and credibility. Advanced business management skills to develop new or enhance existing operational and system strategies, policies and programs. Executive project management skills to lead strategic initiatives, identify business needs, provide effective solutions and manage the necessary resources to accomplish goals and objectives.
