Each year, *U.S. News & World Report* evaluates more than 4,500 medical centers nationwide in 25 specialties, procedures and conditions. According to U.S. News & World Report, hospitals that earned a high performing rating scored significantly better than national average and only 10% of the evaluated hospitals receive a high performing rating. The lung cancer surgery score is determined based on several data categories including patient survival rate, prevention of prolonged hospitalizations, readmissions, volume of patients treated, patient experience and safety, infection rates, and a number of other measures.
