An experienced team at your side

Hospice care is focused on providing the right comfort and dignity to any person with an illness whose life expectancy is measured in months, rather than years. At the McAuley Residence we value your loved ones life. Our team will journey with you and assist you during this very difficult time.

The McAuley Residence Care Team

Our care team focuses on assuring comfort by relieving pain and controlling symptoms 24 hours-a-day, seven days-a-week. Registered nurses, licensed practical nurses, and certified nursing assistants provide around-the-clock care to residents. A physician with expertise in hospice and palliative care medicine oversees each resident's medical care.

The following team members are available as indicated in the care plan for each resident:

- Hospice physician consultant
- Registered nurses
- Licensed practical nurses

- Medical social workers
- Pastoral care chaplains
- Consultant therapists (speech, occupational, music, massage)
- Certified nursing assistants
- Bereavement counselors (13 months of grief support for significant members of resident's family)
- Trained volunteers

What are the admission requirements for hospice care at The McAuley Residence?

Any Hospice Buffalo eligible resident that is in need of 24-hour nursing care during the final weeks to months of life is eligible for admission to Hospice at The McAuley Residence. Admission to Hospice Buffalo is based on a physician's clinical judgement that hospice care would be appropriate for a patient, given the expected course of an illness. Admission is appropriate when:

- A person lives alone and is no longer able to feed or dress themselves
- A person's caregiver is physically or economically unable to provide care at home
- A person lives in an unstable or an unsafe home
- A person does not have adequate family support

Hospice at The McAuley Residence accepts people who otherwise meet eligibility criteria for hospice and admission to The McAuley Residence regardless of race, age, sex, color, religion, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, or disability.

What hospice-related services are offered at The McAuley Residence?

- 24-hour nursing and professional support staffing
- Person centered care philosophy
- Family room with comfortable seating area, TV, and a dining area with refrigerator
- Accommodations are available for a loved one to stay overnight
- Full range of hospice personnel including hospice physician consultant, nurses, medical social workers, pastoral care chaplains, certified nursing assistants, trained volunteers, and bereavement counselors

What payment options are available for hospice at The McAuley Residence?

- Medicaid
- Private pay

We will work with your insurance provider to help find the best possible coverage. Financial assistance may be available for those with limited means. Please ask your social worker or discharge planner to discuss the options or call Hospice Buffalo at (716) 686-8040.

The Medicare Hospice Benefit will cover hospice services, but not room and board. Residents of Hospice at The McAuley Residence are billed for room and board fees that insurance does not cover. However, other arrangements may be available upon request.
